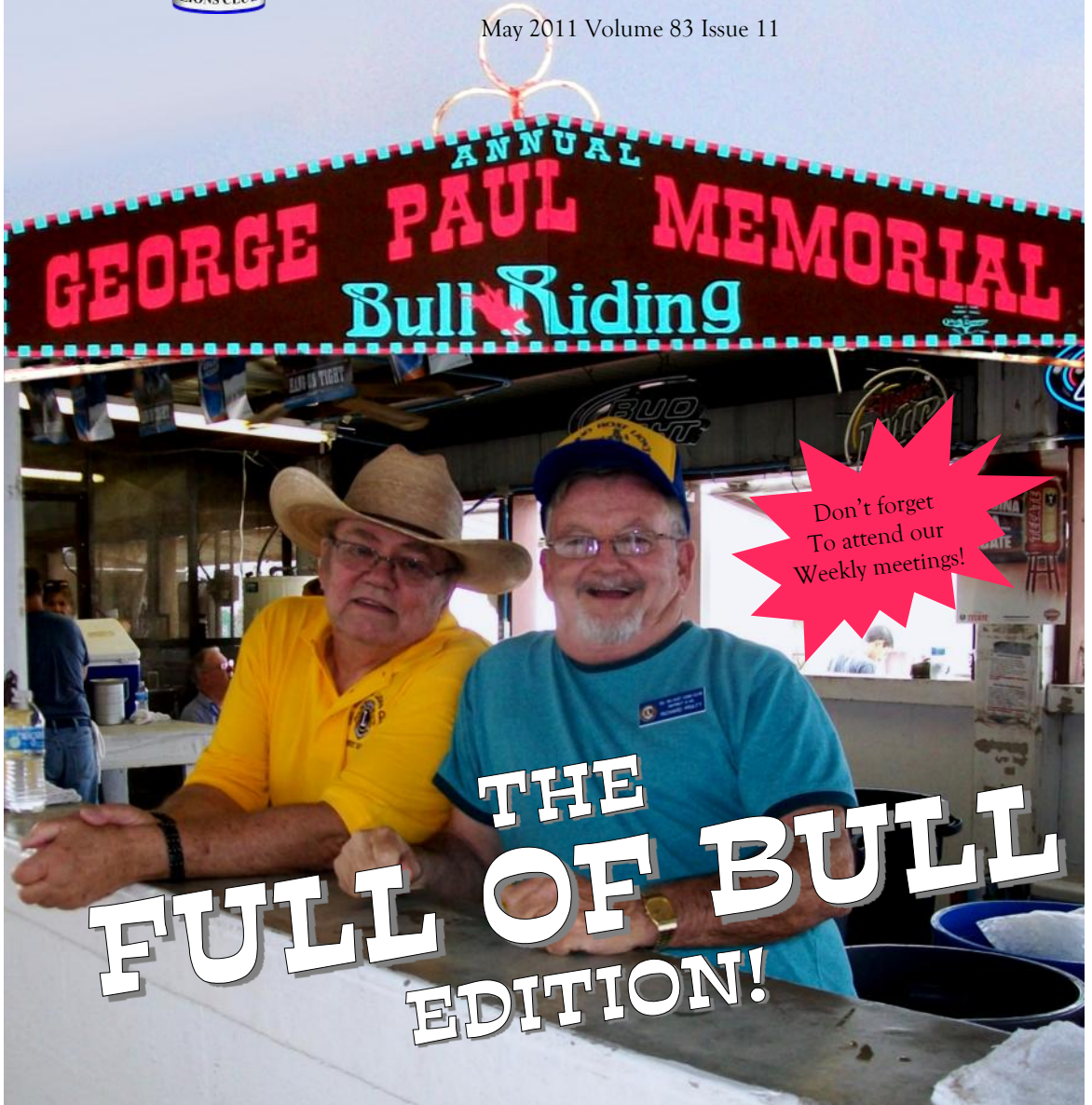

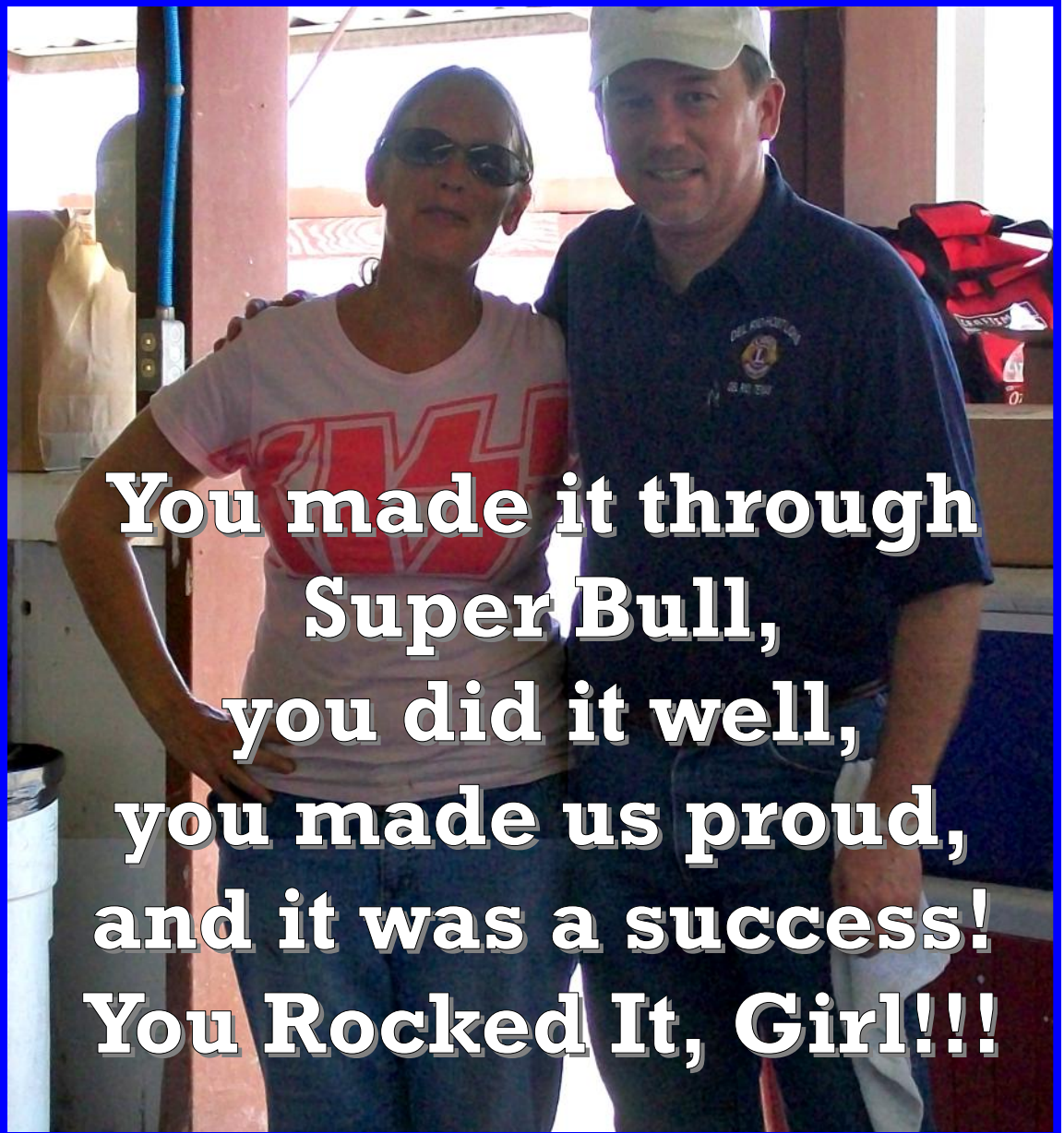

Fighting Fire with...Brisket

The particularly dry weather combined with unusually low humidity and high winds for the area surrounding Val Verde County in South Texas created prime conditions for wildfires. On April 25, this fear was realized when a fire which was later to be named the Deaton-Cole Fire ignited and began burning 65,000 acres 80 miles west of Comstock, Texas. In the neighboring town of Del Rio, Texas, the Del Rio Host Lions Club was already making plans under the direction of one of its members, 2-A2 District Governor John Cole, to serve food and refreshment to the firefighters battling the blaze. In only two days the food and supplies had been gathered and prepared by the club, and the plan set into action.



On Thursday, April 28, District Governor Cole, along with a dozen additional members of the Del Rio Host Lions Club, loaded enough food to provide 100 serv-



ings of Brisket Sandwiches (a club specialty), chips, freshly baked chocolate chip cookies, water and soft drinks. After



a brief stop at the emergency services command center, the food was transported by the Lions (with an escort for

safety) through narrow smoke covered roads, with brushfires crackling and hissing on each side.

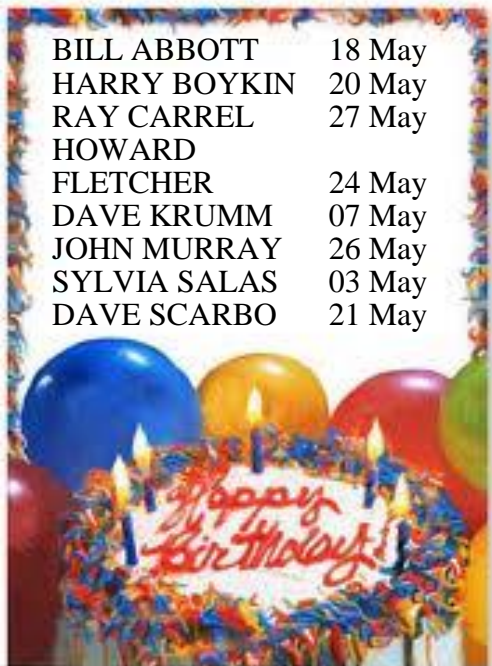
The club met firefighters from Colorado, Arizona, the Texas Army Reserve, and National Forest Service Firefighters from Minnesota, Montana and Utah along with our volunteer firefighters from Val Verde County. Along with a well deserved hot

meal and cool drinks, every one of these men learned about Lions International, and that “We Serve”.

Before the crisis was over, the fire spread to 175,000 acres. But under the cool leadership of another member of the Del Rio Host Lions Club, Val Verde County Judge Laura Allen, the best possible use of resources available to the county was made and with the help of welcome rain, the fire was contained.
